A riot of sound, projections, and sculptures fuse together in John Williams' s kaleidoscopic installation and performance.

Multimedia artist John Williams uses vinyl records, record players, speakers, effect pedals, slides, found objects, and 8 mm projectors to create an ultra-sensory environment of small assemblage sculptures with projections and sounds. Become an active participant in Williams' improvised visual choreography as he converts the gallery space into one giant kinetic sculpture.

Williams received his B.F.A. from Ohio University, Athens, OH and his M.F.A. from the California Institute of the Arts, Valencia, CA. His work has been included in many solo and group exhibitions most recently at Sister and Cottage Home in Los Angeles, CA and he performed in *Spatial Expansion*, *the Oneness and the Suchness* at the Hammer Museum, Los Angeles, CA.
